The Box of Good Examples will introduce you to different inspiring and alternative solutions demonstrated in a light of carried through examples.

The examples are collected from the participating SUREURO countries; Sweden, Finland, Denmark, The Netherlands, Germany, France and England.

The end user; the designers, the advisers and the housing companies, will mainly use this tool for inspiration at the early steps of the refurbishment and for inspiration for the design and construction phase.

The tool has an extensive search function, which allows you to search in the collected database on several levels, the mentioned thematic levels and by sustainable issue.



One of the most important goals for the tool is to ensure that it actually motivates and open up the eyes on our main target groups, the housing companies in Europe, in order to make it easier for them to implement Sustainable Considerations with a more practical attitude directly in their future projects.

The ambition has been to create useful products with a practical user level and yet a high level of scientific content and with extract of the participants high expertise on the different thematic levels.

The tool is planned to help, step by step, along the refurbishment process; from the preliminary considerations through completion of the physical refurbishment to the operation of the newly refurbished building, flat or neighbourhood. The originality is coming from the set of sustainable criteria used all

along the methodology, representing different kinds of concerns:

Sustainable issues:

- Environmental: protection of outdoor environment at different geographic scales (local, regional, global) and protection of Indoor environment (Comfort and Health of the tenants),
- Social/Cultural
- Economical

Conventional issues:

- Technical
- Architectural

The work considers operation on the 3 main thematic and geographic scale levels:

- **Tissue** - urban integration and outdoor layout
- **Support** - the building envelope with its collective areas, called here **Building Complex**
- **Infill** - the dwelling units (indoor private areas).
